PERSIAN LIMES: The Persian lime market has jumped among both big sizes and smaller sizes.

RED CURRANTS: Chilean product is expected to hit the market in December.

'ROJO BRILLANTE' PERSIMMON: The first-of-the-season 'Rojo Brillante' (AKA kaki) persimmon is expected to arrive soon.

'WONDERFUL' POMEGRANATES: Israeli pomegranates are on the water and expected to arrive shortly after Thanksgiving.
